All open cards require 2¢ postage this year. Please separate out of town and local cards. When mailing quantities of cards hand them in at the wickets or tie in bundles with stamps all facing the same way.

Mail early to be sure of delivery.

Use strong rope and heavy paper for wrapping parcels.

When parcels contain more than one article wrap separately and pack tightly.

Following are deadline dates to foreign countries:

Europe - November 21st., United Kingdom - November 25th., United States - December 8th.

United States parcels require customs declarations.
