Ask any question that you are in doubt about and if they are unable to answer it they will get the answer for you. Next, obtain an application card for membership, fill it out and return it along with .25¢ membership fee plus all or part of a share or shares. Here we might quote a portion of the Bylaw regarding new members. "That all new members must own at least one full share within 90 days."
- Q. How much do you expect a person to deposit each payday?
- A. If a Credit Union is living up to the philosophy of Credit Unionism as laid down by Alphonse Desjardins, founder of Credit Union on the North American Continent fifty years ago, that is, 'to promote thrift among its members by encouraging them to deposit a penny, nickle, dime or any other amount which they can get along without'. It is surprising how the habit grows on you, also very surprising how your share Capital will grow with regular and systematic savings plan and in doing so you are preparing yourself for a Rainy Day.
