When in need of a spare, an effort should be made to replace missing players with either someone on the spare list or someone who plays in the same position as the missing player, but if impossible to find anyone but a skip, the spare skip must play as lead and others on the rink move up. Only two spares will be allowed to play on a rink at the same time.
