NEW MEAT MARKET TO OPEN FRIDAY

Tomorrow, Friday, March 14th, the new L & L Meat Market will open its doors to the public. The operators of this newest enterprise in town, Bill Louk and Ralph Lindberg come to us with many years of butchering experience behind them.

A delivery system has now been set up with the co-operation of the Meat Market operators and Pete and Joe Diduch, two of our local truck owners. This new service enables the Meat Market to take phone orders or store orders for delivery in the morning and afternoon. The phone number is Dial 21. Store hours will be from 9:00 a.m. till 5:30 p.m. daily except Wednesday when it will close at 12 noon.

A pleasant bit of news for Terrace Bay residents is the fact that a meat and grocery delivery service will be started tomorrow for a month's trial period.

Delivery prices and times are as follows: Morning Delivery at 10:30 from L. & L. Meat Market and 11:00 from The Bay Groceteria (No. phone orders accepted from The Bay). Afternoon Delivery at 3:30 p.m. from L & L and 4:00 p.m. from the Bay. Anyone wishing to have other parcels picked up and delivered may leave word of same at the Meat Market when placing orders. Prices will be: .15¢ per delivery from the Meat Market and .25¢ from Bay Groceteria. Meat parcels may be left at the Bay with groceries and delivered for one price of .25¢. (Please note: All delivery charges will be collected at destination.) The Bay Groceteria will not accept phone orders for groceries.
