At a recent meeting of the Terrace Bay Accident Prevention Committee, the following policy was established.

As requested, the ambulance will be dispatched to one of three locations:

1. Wood Room - south entrance.
2. Building 11 - west entrance.
3. Main Mill entrance.

When the ambulance is required, phone the switchboard, give details carefully, and the switchboard operator will take it from there.

In the absence of specific information, the ambulance will proceed to the main mill entrance.
