ANGLING DATES AND CATCH ANNOUNCED

The opening dates for angling were  
announced today by the Departments of Lands  
and Forests office in Port Arthur.

Pickereel, closed from April 15 to May  
14 inclusive and then opened. Maximum, six  
per day. Minimum length 13 inches.

Speckled trout, open from May 1st to  
Sept. 15th. Maximum, 15 per day or an ag-  
gregate weight of no more than 10 pounds.  
Minimum length, seven inches.

Bass, open July 1st to October 15th.  
Maximum, six per day. Minimum length 10  
inches.

Lake trout, no closed season. Maxi-  
mum, five per day, any size.

Pike, no closed season. Maximum, six  
per day. No size limit.

If an angler is out more than two days,  
he can have a two-days catch in possession  
for all species. Anyone living outside of  
Ontario must have a non-residence licence.
