Indications from the 1st few days of testing headlights are that most of the autos in Terrace Bay are operating with improperly adjusted headlights. About 3 out of 4 cars tested have not passed the safety lane test the 1st time through.

The most common fault is that of lights being set too low. Most drivers feel that this is not particularly unsafe because then there is small chance of blinding oncoming drivers. However, if your lights are too low, Mr. Driver, remember that chances are you are overdriving your lights. That is, you will not see objects far enough ahead to properly control your car in case of an emergency.
