BISIC CHILD PSYCHOLOGY

Parenthood is the most important job in the world. If this is true there should be educational opportunities for preparing for it -- and there are.

The Recreation Committee has an opportunity available to sponsor interested people at an Institute of Family Relations Clinic in Schreiber from September 8th to the 12th, from 2:00 to 5:00 p.m. and from 7:00 to 10:00 p.m. each day.

The instructor is Mrs. F. L. Johnson, Institute of Child Study, University of Toronto.

This first course covers the basic principles of child training and the course subject is "Discipline".

After first taking the basic course with a psychologist, you will then have an opportunity of taking four more courses by correspondence.

The four correspondence course are:
Pre-School Learning
The School Age Child
Adolescence
Family Relationships.

It is hoped that those taking the course will volunteer later to menitor parent study groups in Terrace Bay. There is, however, no obligation connected with the project.
