be notified and a report sent to your family physician.

(c) If the film shows shadowing which might represent tuberculosis, you will be asked to return for further examination by a chest specialist and for further full size films. There is no charge for this additional service. The examiner will discuss any abnormal condition with you and will send a report to your family physician.

Q. What happens when examination shows that treatment for tuberculosis is required?

A. Arrangements are made with the patient for admission to a sanatorium.

Q. Who pays for care in the sanatorium?

A. Provision is made by the Department of Health for the treatment of those patients who are themselves unable to pay for such; unless a patient can contribute without hardship he is not requested to do so.

Q. When the "breadwinner" of a family enters sanatorium will the family receive any financial assistance?

A. If assistance is required, mothers with children under 16 years of age become eligible for Mothers' Allowances and if necessary municipal welfare is available.

Q. Who pays for the free chest X-ray service in my home district?

A. The Ontario Department of Health, in cooperation with your local unit of the Ontario Tuberculosis Association. Your O.T.A. district unit is supported in its work by your purchase of Christmas Seals.
