IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT NOTICE

The following is taken from BY-LAW 45A of The Corporation of the Improvement District of Terrace Bay.

- 2A. No person shall permit his or her dog to run at large in the Townsite of Terrace Bay, and all dogs must be tied up at all times, except at follows:
 - 1. When on a chain or lead, accompanied by the owner or some other
 competent person.
 - 2. Dogs may be permitted to run at large between the hours of 8 p.m. and 11 p.m. daily.

A fine of \$5.00 is provided for each and every infraction of paragraph 2A.
