FOR THE INFORMATION OF ADULTS WHO MAY BE WATCHING MINOR LEAGUE BASEBALL GAMES, HERE ARE SOME OF THE RULE ADJUSTMENTS

Playing Rules

The batter shall not be allowed to advance to first base on a third strike dropped by the catcher. He is automatically out. When a pitcher is in contact with the pitcher's rubber with the ball in his possession, base runners shall not leave their bases until after the ball has been delivered and has reached the batter.

(1) When a base runner leaves his base too soon, and the batter does not hit the ball the runner is permitted to continue. If a play is made on him and he is out, the out stands. If he is safe on the play, or if no play is made on him, he must return to the base he previously occupied and no out results. All other runners shall be required to return to the base they occupied at the time the play started.

(2) In the event runners illegally advance and cannot be returned to their bases due to the batter having hit the ball, they shall be required to return to the base unoccupied nearest the one they left.

Example: PLAY--Runner on first. He leaves base too soon and the batter hits double, runner scoring. RULING--Runner returns to third,

Legal Game

Games shall be played six innings. In the case of tie scores at the end of six innings the game shall go into extra innings.

It is a regulation game if it be called by the umpire on account of darkness, rain or other cause which in the umpire's judgment interferes with further play, provided four or more equal innings have been played; or $3\frac{1}{2}$ innings shall constitute a legal game if the team second at bat shall have scored more runs at the end of its third inning than the team first at bat has scored in its four complete innings.
