Pitching Rules

A team shall not have more than 4 eligible pitchers for the season whose names must be registered with the President before the league commences play.

A pitcher shall not be allowed to pitch more than nine full innings in any one calendar week, provided, however, that if he is pitching in the sixth inning of a tie game he may continue to pitch until the conclusion of the game.

A pitcher shall not be started or inserted in a game if the number of innings remaining to be played, plus the number of innings previously pitched by him in the same calendar week equals more than 9 innings.

A pitcher shall not be allowed to pitch unless he has had at least 60 hours rest after pitching four or more innings.

A manager shall not be allowed to change pitchers more than 3 times in any one game.

Violation of any of the above pitching rules renders the pitcher involved ineligible for the game in which the violation occurred and such ineligibility is subject to protest.
