## moose season open nov. 20

On November 20th the hunters will be on the loose - after moose. The season is open until December 15th south of the most northern C. N.R. line, for Bull Moose only. Licenses may be obtained from the Department of Lands and Forests at Pays Platt.

The open season for hunting deer closes on November 25th.

For all potential hunters we print here-with:

The following summary of Ontario game and fishery laws and regulations has been issued by the Department of Lands and Forests for the guidance and convenience of the hunting public:

It is illegal to:

1. Carry any firearms without authority of a license, on your person.
2. Give false information regarding a license.
3. Hold more than one license to hunt deer or moose in any one year.
4. Transfer a license from one person to another.
5. Hunt deer with a dog unless there are two or more licensed hunters per dog and the dog is licensed.
6. Act as a guide without a license.
7. For a non-resident to hunt moose without a licensed guide.
8. Have a Farmer's Deer License unless living upon and tilling the soil of his own farm. (License restricted to one per household).
9. Have a Camp Deer License unless there are four or more licensed hunters.
10. Possess firearms between a half hour after sunset and one-half hour before sunrise unless it is unloaded and dismantled or encased.
11. Discharge a firearm on, from or across a public highway or roadway.
12. Discharge a firearm from a moving vehicle, aircraft or power boat.
13. Have a loaded firearm in a motor car, aircraft or other vehicle.
14. Use or be in possession of a shotgun which is capable of holding more than three shells at one time.
15. Carry a firearm of greater calibre than a .22 low-powered rifle or a shotgun with larger than No. 2 shot during the open season for deer or moose unless the hunter has a deer or moose license.
16. A gun is deemed loaded if the shells are in any part of the firearm.
17. Give to any other person game unless there is a letter with it showing the name address and license number of the donor.
18. To export fish or game out of the Province except under authority of Non-Resident license.
19. Conceal a deer or moose, or any part thereof, while transporting, moving or shipping same.
20. Use a night light or live decoys or bait while hunting migratory birds.
21. Shoot deer or moose while they are swimming in any waters.
22. To enter upon private property whether it is enclosed or not after the hunter has been given notice by word of mouth by the owner or by writing or by posters or sign
