RECIPE OF THE WEEK

SALMON SCALLOP

- 4 tablespoons butter or margarine
- 4 tablespoons flour
- ½ teaspoon salt
- ¼ teaspoon pepper
- 2 cups milk
- 1 pound can salmon, drained and flaked
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- 1 cup canned tomatoes, drained
- 2 hard cooked eggs, sliced
- ½ cup grated cheese
- ½ cup dry bread crumbs
- ¼ cup crumbled potatoe chips

Heat oven to moderate (375 degrees F.) Butter a 1½ quart casserole. Melt 4 tablespoons butter in a suacepan. Blend in flour, salt, pepper, Add milk. Cook until thick, stirring. Combine salmon, remaining ingredients. Add cream sauce. Place in casserole and top with potato chip crumbs. Bake 25 minutes. Makes 8 servings.
