Areas laid out in townsites, switching grounds, station grounds, railway rights of way, water powers capable of producing at least 150 horsepower, or lands acquired in the pullic interest, or set aside for special use, are not open for staking. Lands in Indian Reserves may be staked but permission must be obtained from thelocal Indian Agent and such claims are recorded with the Indian Affairs Branch at Ottawa.

There are a number of townships in the Clay Belt south of Kirkland Lake that are both potential farm lands and potential mining lands. By special arrangement, mining claims have are limited to mining rights only, in order that the soil may remain open for homesteading.
