<u>FISH</u>	<u>SEASON</u>	<u>LIMITS OF CATCH</u>	<u>LENGTH</u>
SPECKLED TROUT	May 1 - Sept. 15	1 plus an additional 14 per day, provided additional 14 in aggregate weight not more than 10 lbs.	Not less than 7 inches.
RAINBOW TROUT	May 1-Sept. 15	5 in one day	Not less than 7 inches.
LAKE TROUT	No closed season	5 in one day	Any size.
WALLEYE PIKE (Pickerel)	May 22-April 14 (Nearly 11 months)	6 in one day	Not less than 15 inches.
GREAT NORTHERN PIKE	No closed season	6 in one day	Any size.
BLACK BASS	July 1-Oct. 15	6 in one day	Not less than 11 inches.
MASKINONGE (Muskie)	June 20-Oct. 15	2 in one day	Not less than 30 inches.

NOTE: POSSESSION LIMIT SHALL NOT EXCEED ONE DAY'S CATCH. LENGTH IS MEASURED FROM TIP OF HEAD (JAWS CLOSED) TO TIP OF TAIL (LOBES COMPRESSED).
