WATER HEATERS TO GO ON FLAT RATE

At the Improvement District Meeting on Wednesday, May 26th it was decided to place all townsite water heaters on a flat rate rather than on the present meter rate.

The following domestic rate comparisons apply:

Present Rate

40KWH @ 3.5¢, 180 @ 1.6¢ Balance @ 0.75¢ Service Charge 56¢.

New Rate

60KWH @ 2.7¢ Balance @ 1.0¢ 35¢ per installed 100 watts for water heater.

The new rates and the flat rate for water heaters will result in a reduction in cost of power to domestic consumers. Flat Rate for Water Heaters Will Be 500 Watt Heater \$1.75 per month 1000 Watt Heater \$3.50 per month 2000 Watt Heater \$7.00 per month Budget

In 1953 \$1900 more than was in the approved budget was spent for road service in Terrace Bay. This amount was more than the Department of Highways had approved in last years budget in which their 50% subsidy would apply. However, notification was received that the Deptarment of Highways agreed to pay their 50% subsidy on this \$1900.00. Result a saving of approximately \$900.00
