LOCAL MAN DELEGATE AT MEETING REPRESENTING 312,000 IN ONTARIO.

Verne Hopper of Terrace Bay was a delegate to the Ontario Credit Union League Annual Convention in the Royal York Hotel, Toronto during May 20th, 21st and 22nd. This is the fourteenth annual meeting of the League delegates, who represent 312,000 people in Ontario, members of 946 savings and loan associations operating under charters from the Ontario government.

member credit unions in Ontario have over \$75,000,000 in assets, and at present have some \$65,000,000 out on loan to members, League General Manager John Hallinan announced to the convention.
