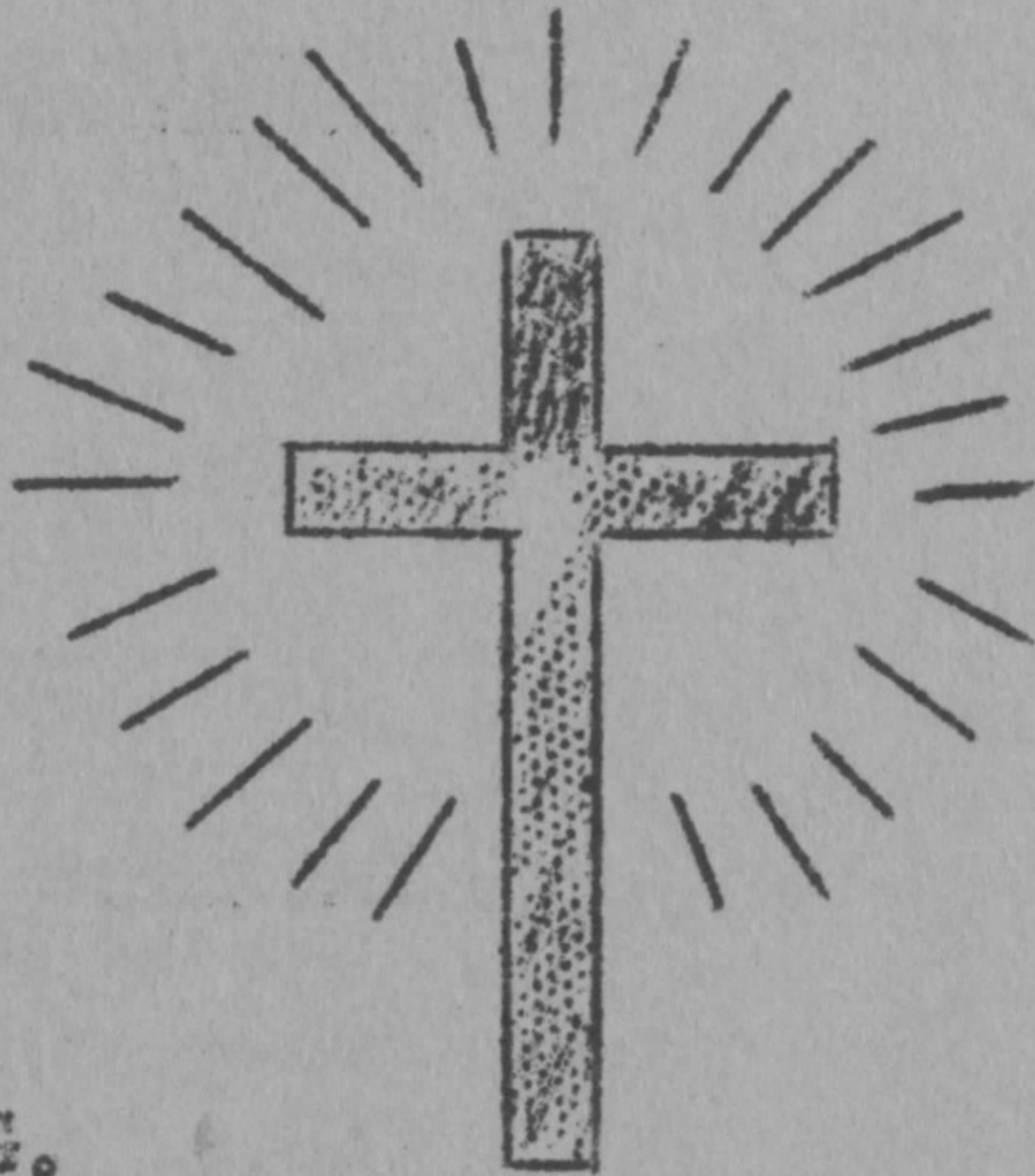
BOY SCOUT NEWS
