



RECIPE OF THE WEEK
CHOCOLATE NAPOLEONS

- 1/4 cup butter or margarine
- 1/2 pound marshmallows
(about 2 1/2 dozen)
- 2 squares unsweetened chocolate
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla
- 4 cups oven-popped rice cereal

Measure into a double boiler, the butter, marshmallows and chocolate. Cook over hot water until thick and syrupy. Add vanilla.

Place cereal in large buttered bowl. Pour chocolate mixture over cereal, stirring briskly to coat well. Press into greased shallow pan to 1/4-inch or less thickness.

When cool cut into bars 4 by 1 1/2 inches. Press three bars together with a thick custard filling between.

CUSTARD FILLING

- 1 1/2 tablespoons cornstarch
- 5 tablespoons granulated sugar
- Few grains salt
- 1 cup milk, heated
- 1 egg
- 1/2 teaspoon vanilla.

In top of double boiler, combine cornstarch, sugar and salt. Slowly stir in hot milk. Cook over hot water, stirring constantly until mixture is thick.

Continue cooking for 15 minutes. Add egg beaten slightly, and cook another 5 minutes.

Remove from heat. Add vanilla. Cool. Use as filling for Napoleons, layer cake or cream puffs.
