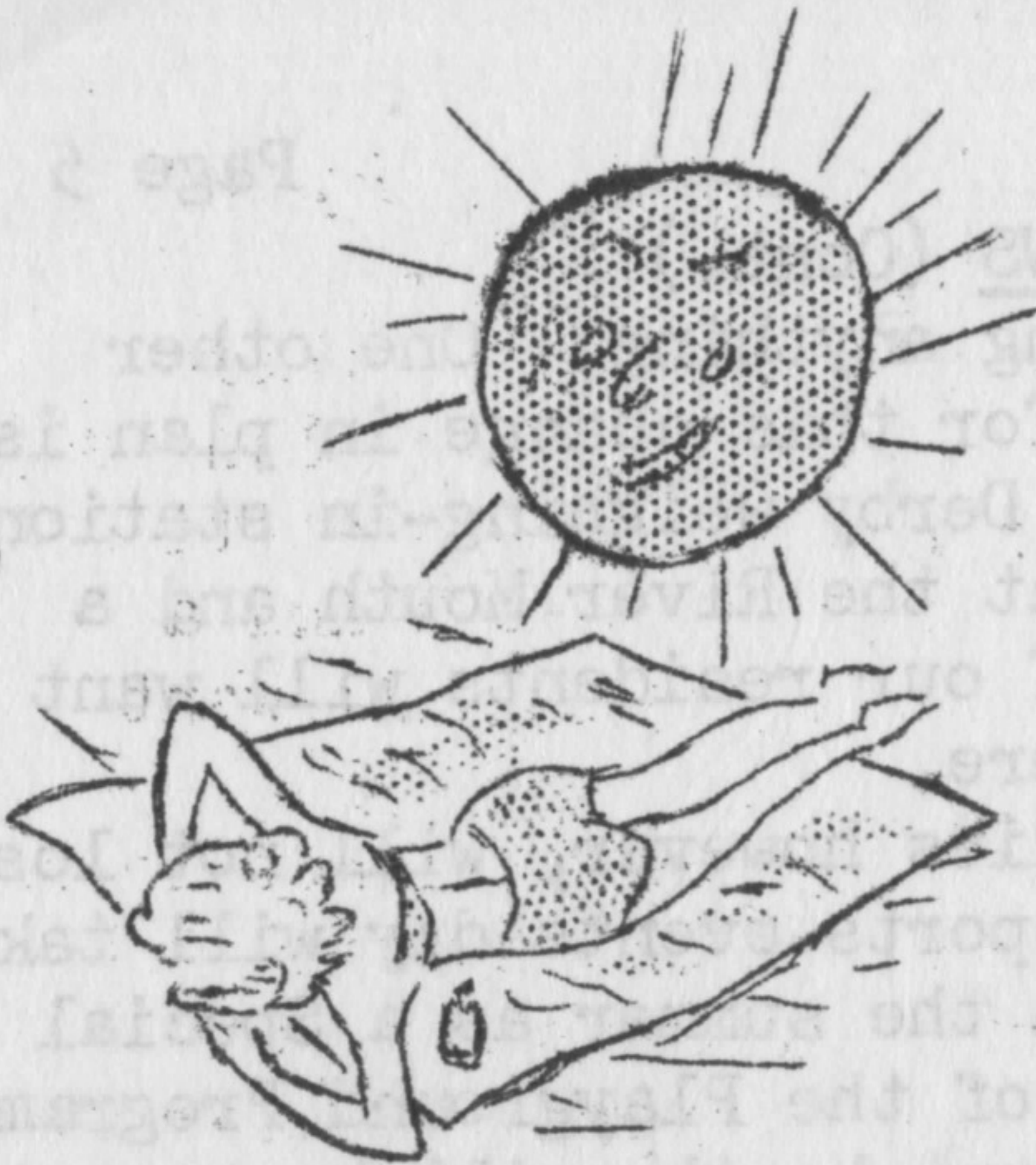

RECIPE OF THE WEEK  
BUTTERSCOTCH OAT SQUARES

- 1/2 cup butter, melted  
1 cup brown sugar (firmly packed)  
1/2 teaspoon vanilla  
1 teaspoon baking power  
2 cups Robin Hood Oats

Combine brown sugar, baking powder and oats in mixing bowl. Add butter and vanilla. Blend thoroughly. Spread thinly in ungreased square or oblong cake tins. For this amount of mixture, 2 tins (8 x 8 x 2 inches) or equivalent are required.

Bake at 375°F. (Moderately hot oven) for 8 to 10 minutes or until golden brown. Remove from oven. Allow to stand for 5 minutes. While still warm cut in squares or bars with sharp knife.

Loosen outside edges. Allow to cool thoroughly, then remove squares or bars from tins.

Yield -- 3 dozen squares.

Note: Best results are obtained with moist brown sugar.
