There will be three or four persons to help direct the traffic, but your whole-hearted co-operation will be needed. The weighing in deadline is 6:00 p.m. so be sure to have your fish in on time.

Just a few lines about safety now, but they are important! Don't overload your boat. Be careful entering and leaving the river mouth. There are a few rocks to look out for. If possible these will be marked. Be sure to carry ample fuel (Gas). Be sure you have your compass in your pocket before you start out. The fog around Lake Superior comes in very suddenly at times.

Don't forget, there will probably be someone on shore waiting to see you come in. Don't disappoint them!!!
