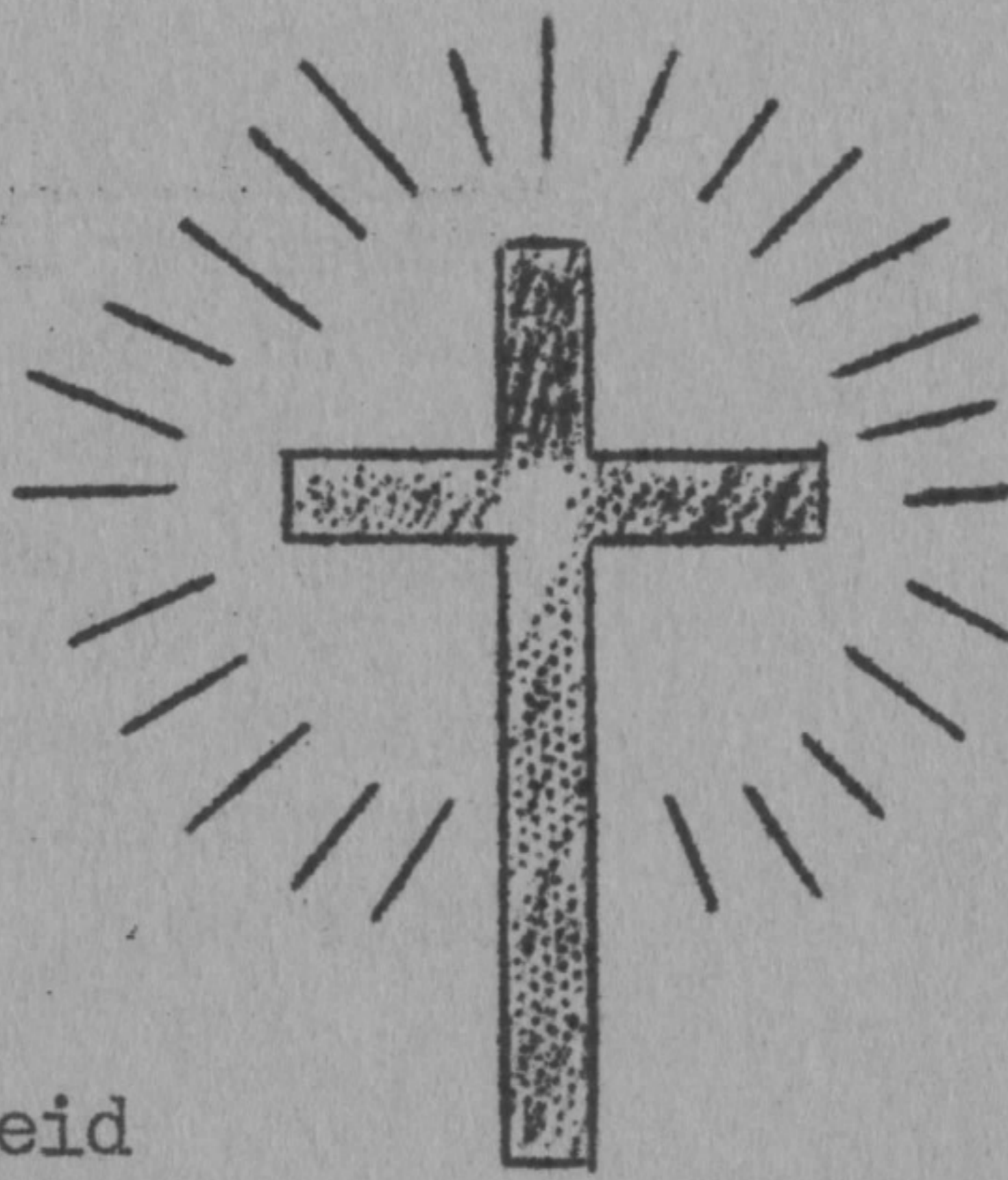
CUB CAMP
