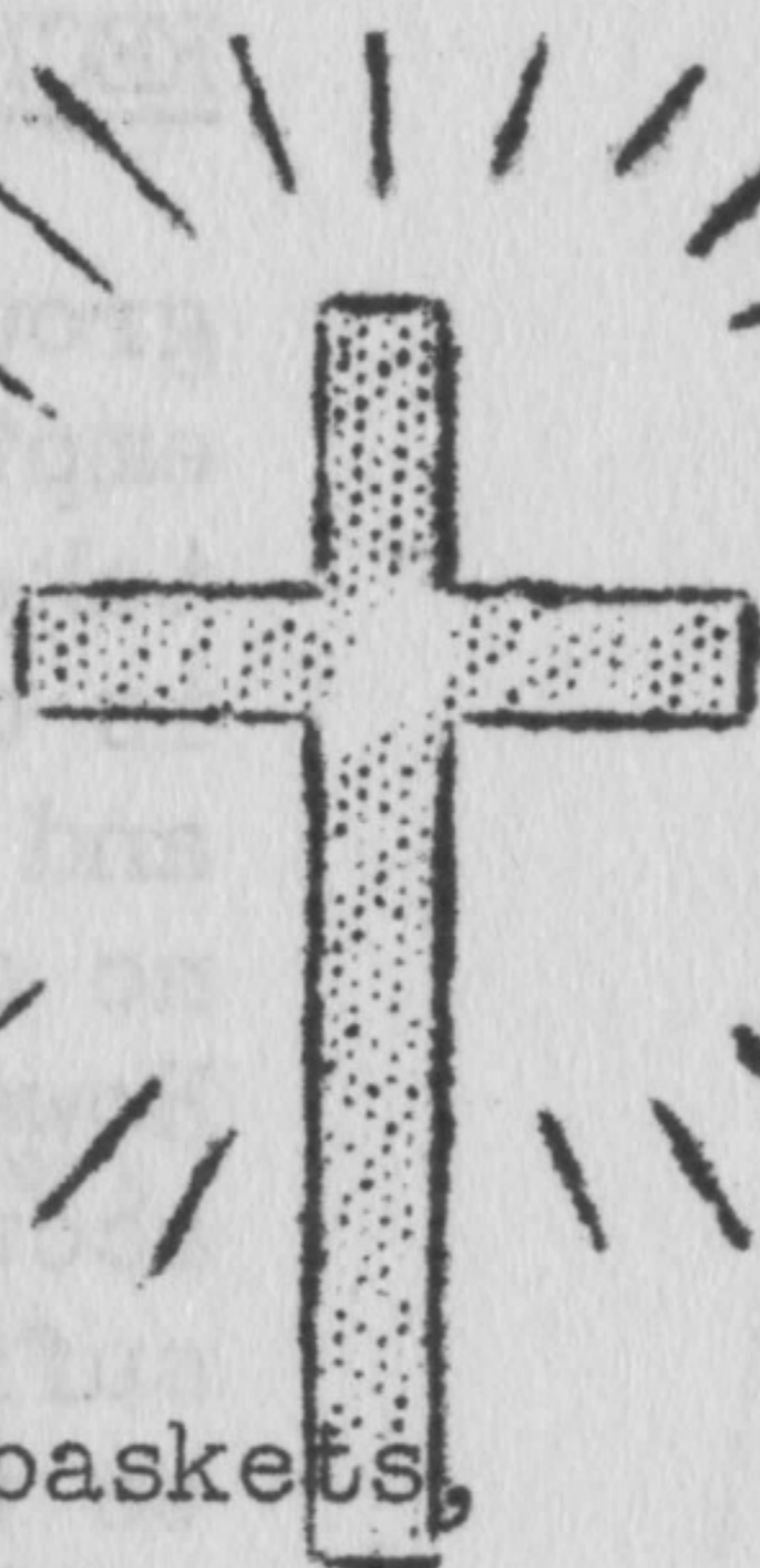
Minutes of the Last Meeting - Gene Fowler
