



RECIPE OF THE WEEK  
CHIPNUT CHEWS

- 1/2 cup soft butter or margarine
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1 egg
- 2 cups pancake mix
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 1/2 cup semi-sweet chocolate pieces
- 1/2 cup finely chopped nuts

Heat oven to 375 degrees F. Have ready a jelly roll pan.

Blend butter and sugar thoroughly. Add egg and mix well.

Stir in pancake mix and vanilla. Spread dough in jelly roll pan (approx. 10 1/2 by 15 1/2 inches) or in two pans (7 by 11 inches).

Sprinkle with chocolate pieces and nuts, pressing them into dough slightly.

Bake in moderately hot oven about 15 minutes. Remove from oven and while still warm, mark into bars, cutting part way through. Cool, cut and remove from pan.

Orange Chipnut - Add grated rind of an orange to butter-sugar mixture.

Coconut Chip Chews: Substitute 1/2 cup coconut for nuts.
