CINNAMON SLICES

cup butter or margarine
cup brown sugar
egg, beaten
tablespoon milk
teaspoon vanilla
cup finely chopped nuts
teaspoons cinramon
cups pancake mix

Blend butter and sugar thoroughly.
Add egg, milk and vanilla and beat until
fluffy.

Stir in nuts, cinnamon and pancake mix.

Shape dough into long rolls about 1 1/2 inches in diameter. Wrap in heavy waxed paper and chill several hours or overnight.

Cut rolls into 1/4-inch slices. Bake on ungreased baking sheet in a moderately hot oven of 375 degrees F. for 10 minutes. Yield - 3 dozen cookies.
