Without some additional assistants, Cubmaster Wills may have to cut the size of the pack, instead of taking in boys now on the waiting list. It looks like there'll be enough boys too warrant forming a new pack within a year or two, but at present we haven't enough adult leaders for one.

The Group Committee is making an earnest appeal to all of the men and women of Terrace Bay to seriously consider volunteering their services as a cub leader. Did we say "women"? Yes, many of the cub leaders in Canada are women. We would like to have one or two women assistants in the Terrace Bay pack.

The most common excuse for not being a Cub or Scout leader is that the person was never a Cub or Scout. It just isn't necessary. All you need is the willingness to work with boys of 8 to 11 years one night a week. We'll supply the training. Shift work is no deterrant, but we'd prefer someone from a shift other than #3.

The minimum age is 18 -- and there is no upper limit.
