RECIPE OF THE WEEK (Cont.)BUTTERSCOTCH ROLLS

Sift together flour, baking powder and salt into mixing bowl, Cut shortening into small pieces. Add to dry ingredients. Blend together until mixture is mealy, using pastry blender (or two knives, cutting in with scissor-like motion). Make a well in the centre of the mixture and gradually add the milk stirring lightly with a fork. Mix only until soft dough is formed. Turn dough onto lightly floured bakeboard or pastry cloth. With lightly floured rolling pin roll dough to form a square 12 x 12 inches, about one-quarter inch thick. Spread with remaining butterscotch mixture. Roll up firmly like a jelly roll, and with a sharp knife, slice roll in 12 pieces about one inch thick. Place one slice, cut side up, in each muffin pan.

Bake at 425°F. (Hot oven) for 15 to 20 minutes. Turn out of pan immediately after removing from oven.
