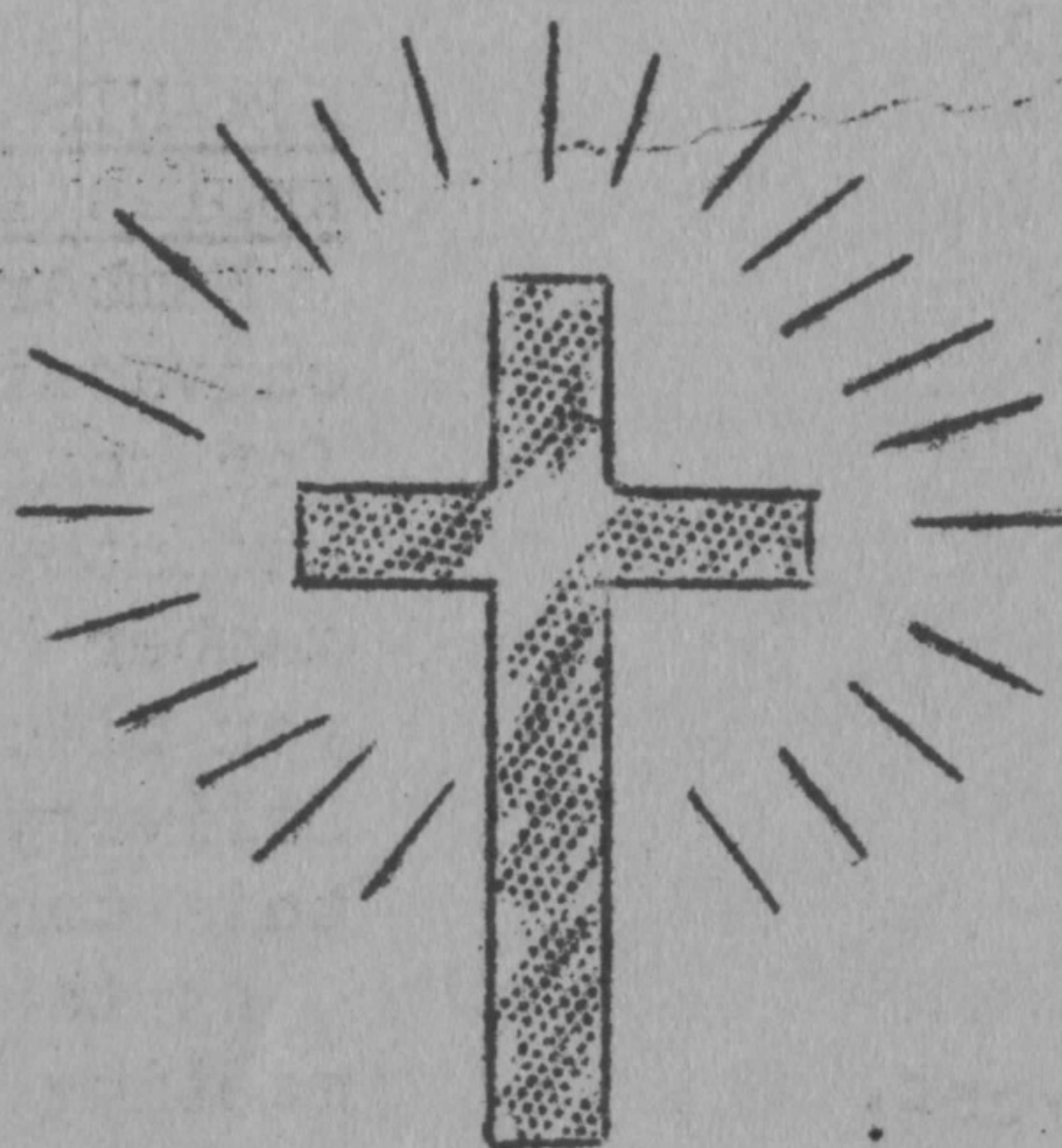
All in all a very interesting program has been planned - all members and friends are cordially invited to attend.
