MENS CURLING---- PLAY FOR DIVISION----

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

In order to group the 30 rinks into five divisions of six rinks in each a partial round robin will be played between now and the official opening of the Recreation Centre. Division grouping will be established by total points and total wins.

Each rink will play 4 games for placement and these will not count as points

for the season draw.

This year for scheduling purposes each rink will have a number which will be your rink number for the entire season. This makes scheduling easier and allows less space to be used. Learn your rink number.

Last week in the News rinks were listed at random according to their grouping by the membership committee. This was the basis for rink numbering as the first name on the list is No. 1 the second No. 2 and so on.
