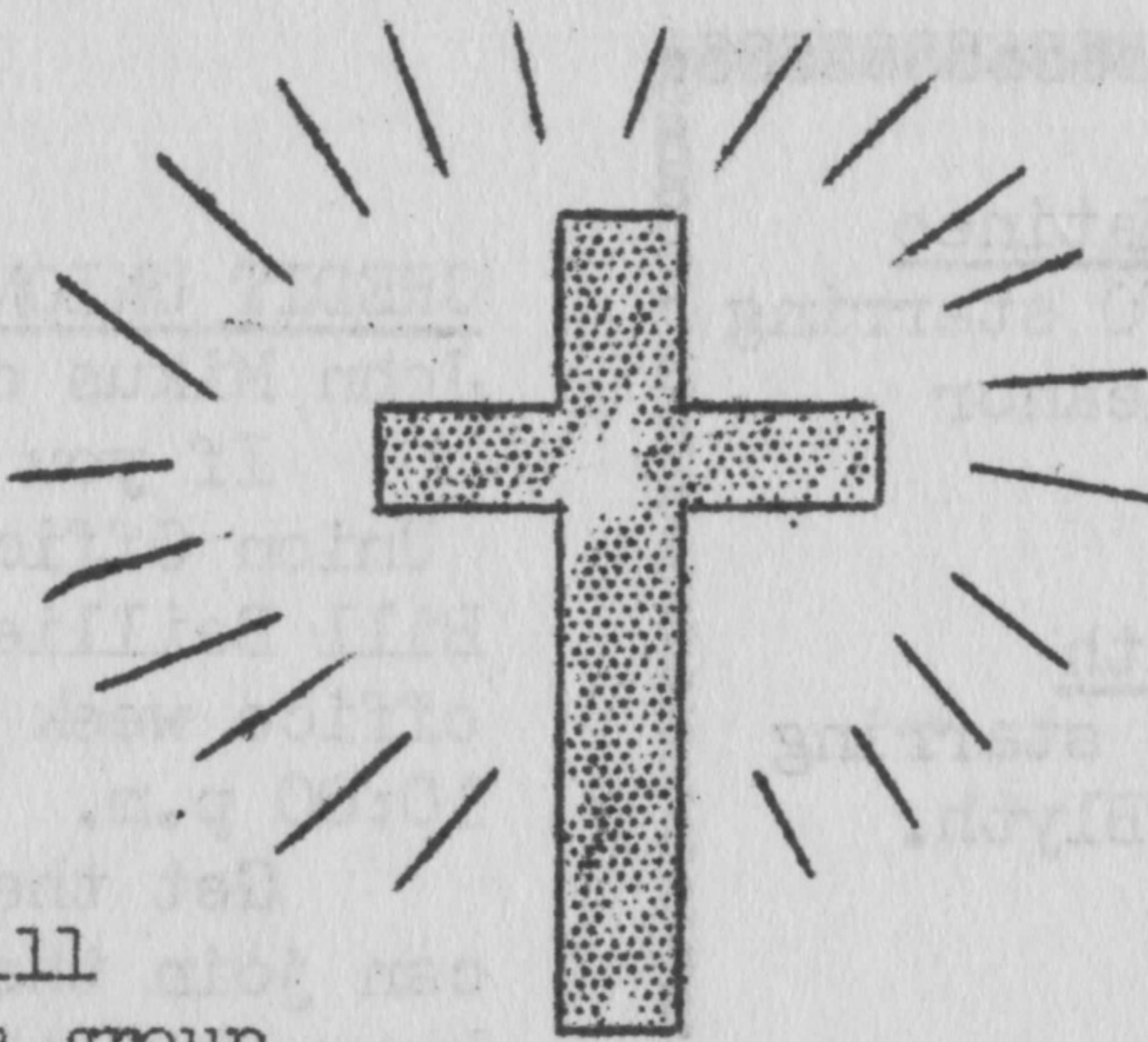
LIBRARY NEWSThe Power and the Prize - Howard Swiggett
