RECIPE OF THE WEEK

SHORT PASTRY

- 1 1/2 cups pastry flour
- 1/2 cup fat (half lard and half butter)
- 1 teaspoon salt
- Ice Water (about 1/4 cup)

Sift flour and salt. Cut the fat into small pieces and rub the fat into the flour using the finger tips until the mixture looks like fine breadcrumbs. With a knife, add drops of water mixing lightly so that the flour and fat are coated, adding the water where the mixture is dry, until the somewhat dry dough leaves the bowl clean. Handle as little as possible.

Flour the pastry cloth or board lightly, also the rolling pin, and roll the pastry lightly and quickly away from you. If possible place dough in refrigerator or cool place to chill for 30 minutes or more. Good for fruit pies and tarts.
