TERRACE TAKES MARATHON 6-3

It was a bruising game from start to finish. Officials worked hard to keep up to the rough-house type of play that dominated all three periods. During the 60 minutes of hockey 29 penalties were handed out (14 to Terrace Bay, 15 to Marathon). When bruises and goals were tallied up Terrace Bay was on the long end of a 6-3 score. Last season's cellar-dwellers had toppled the champs of the '53-'54 North Shore loop by a decisive margin.

It all took place last Saturday night in Terrace Bay's new arena as part of the opening festivities of the

Memorial Recreation Centre.

Marathon opened the scoring at 4:25 of the first period on an unasisted goal by Kosolowski. Before the goal was scored, six peralties had been handed out.

At the 12 minute mark, Terrace tied the score as Desrosier poked one past Jorgensen in an assist from Moro.

With play 4 minutes along in the 2nd period "Superiors" moved ahead as Hayes set up the play whereby Stachiw scored. "Mercuries" tied it up at 10:10 when Amadeao rifled one past Weaver on a pass from Charyna. Twenty-two seconds later Osmar tallied from Brassard to give Terrace a 3-2 margin.

Early in the 3rd period Desrosier chalked up his 2nd counter with assists to Moro and Lang. A couple of minutes later Bond flipped one in Marathon's net on a beautiful passing play from Hayes to Stachiw. At 17:00 Knight made it 6-2 for Terrace Bay with help from Moro and Osmar. A minute later Marathon
