RECIPE OF THE WEEK

5 quarts (20 cups) diced,  
cooked chicken  
3 cups salad dressing  
1 tablespoon salt  
8 cups diced celery  
6 cups chopped cucumber  
16 hard-cooked eggs, chopped  
3 cups sliced, toasted almonds  
18 to 20 pounds of ready-to-cook stewing  
chickens will yield approximately 5 quarts  
diced, cooked chicken.

Mix celery, cucumber, hard-  
cooked eggs, salt and salad dressing  
with the diced cooked chicken.

Fold in toasted almonds  
just before serving.
