(50 servings of 3/4 cup)

quarts (20 cups) diced,
cooked chicken

cups salad dressing
tablespoon salt
cups diced celery
cups chopped cucumber
hard-cooked eggs, chopped
cups sliced, toasted almonds
pounds of ready-to-cook stewing
chickens willyield approximately 5 quarts
diced, cooked chicken.

Mix celery, cucumber, hardcooked eggs, salt and salad dressing with the diced cooked chicken.

Fold in toasted almonds just before serving.
