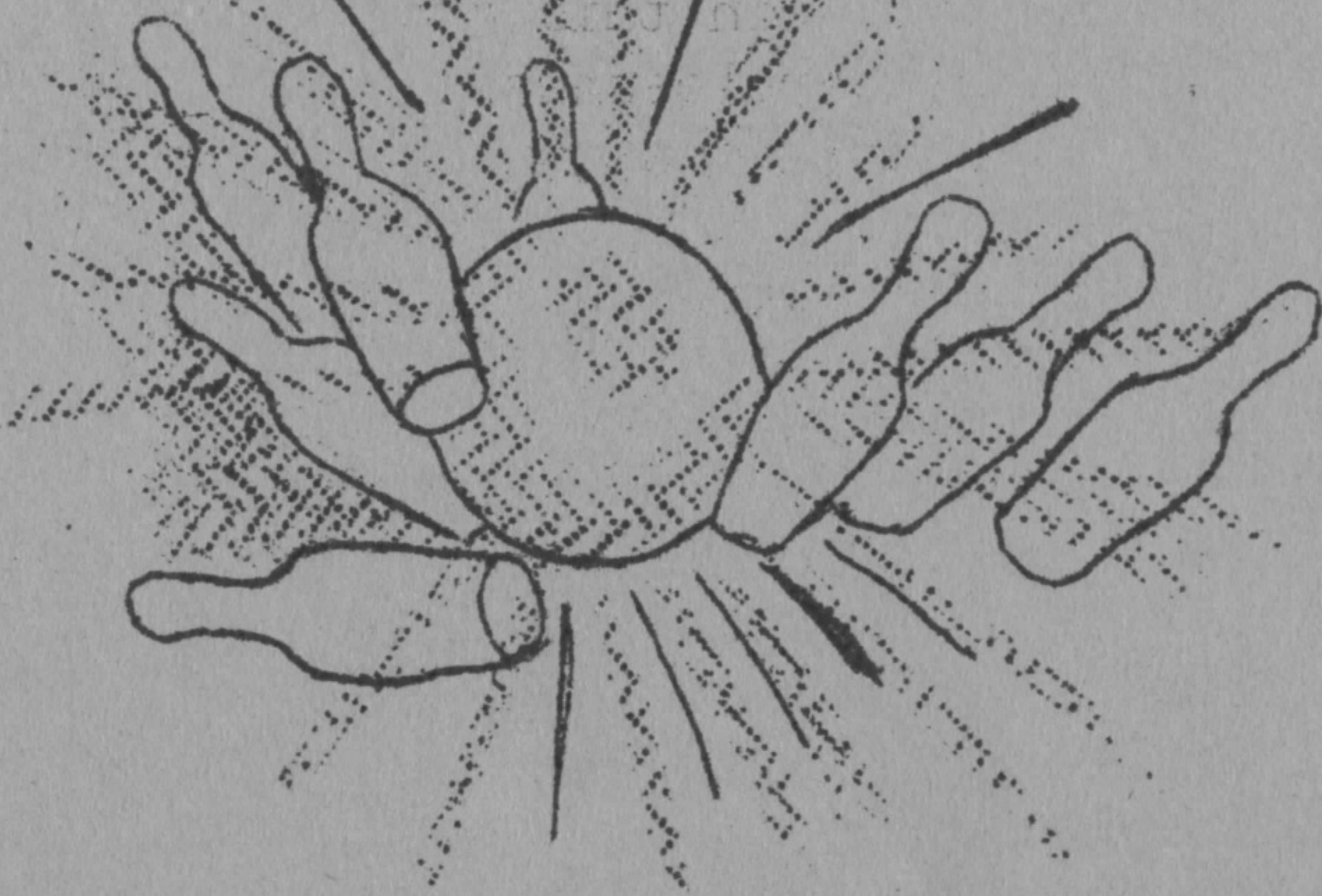


Bowling News
