What Your Credit Union is Doing

As we go along in our daily lives doing the jobs that keep body and soul together, let's just stop for a moment to glance at what your Credit Union is doing to maintain a way of life.

Since November last year, the Credit Union has loaned \$10,602.00 in 74 loans. Breaking it down to an average it simply means that 74 people borrowed \$143.40 each from the Credit Union to help them along in their every day lives.

Loans are mostly made on character and naturally you must belong to the Credit Union.

You can readily see that the Credit Union is fulfilling its purpose, and that is to provide low-cost loans as well as insurance to cover these loans at no extra cost.

But that is not the only feature about Credit Unions, another one is to instil a sense of thrift and to provide a means of saving. For this we have a payroll deduction plan with the LongLac Pulp and Paper Company. At one time or another everyone is faced with the necessity of borrowing money. To some this is an onerous task. They hate to ask their friends and they do not wish to become involved with high rate lenders.

This one of the main reasons that your fellow employees have formed a Credit Union. In fact this is one reason why there are so many credit unions.
