SAFETY STEEPLECHASE STARTS FEB. 1ST

On February 1st, a new contest "SAFETY STEEPLECHASE" will get underway. Involved will be every employee on the LongLac payroll. The contest will run for 4 months ending at midnight, May 31st.

In all there will be six units. Names of units with approximate numbers in each are:

Wood Handling	-	90
Pulp	-	125
Engineering	-	185
Services	-	70
Townsite	-	65
Technical & Admin. Office	-	60

(Any major change in unit totals will be recognized and adjusted)

Purpose of the contest will be to see which unit can build up the most points during the 4-month contest period.

POINTS WILL BE CREDITED AS FOLLOWS:

1. One point per day per man (on a 7 day week basis) for every day a unit works without a lost time accident.
2. Good Housekeeping Bonuses
 - (a) 1000 points each month to best unit
 - (b) 750 " " " " 2nd " "
 - (c) 500 " " " " 3rd " "

(Good Housekeeping bonuses will be determined by a specially appointed committee)

POINTS WILL BE DEBITED AS FOLLOWS

1. Lost-time Accidents
 - (a) 30 x number of employees in unit involved - plus -
 - (b) Days lost x number of employees in unit involved (up to a max. of 30 days)

SAFETY STEEPLECHASE (Cont.)

2. Doctor-Care Cases

5 x number of employees in unit involved

3. Unreported Accidents (no matter how slight)

15 x number of employees in unit involved

As an example, let's take a look at what might happen to a 100 man unit over a 90 day period:

Total points at the end of 90 days			- 4200.

PRIZES WILL BE AWARDED ON THIS BASIS:

1. One dollar (\$1.00) per employee to each unit working throughout the 4 months contest without a lost-time accident.
2. A grand prize of \$250.00 to the unit finishing the contest with the most points.

Department Safety Committees will decide what to do with award money. There is only one reservation, cash must not be distributed.

Excepting for Good Housekeeping, all disputes and decisions shall be made by the
