

IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT OF TERRACE BAY  
BY LAW 45A, SECTION 2 IS AS FOLLOWS

"No person shall permit his or her dog to run at large in the Improvement District, without having around its neck the collar and tag mentioned in the first section of this By-Law.

2A No person shall permit his or her dog to run at large except as follows:

1. When on a chain or lead, accompanied by the owner or some other competent person.

2. Dogs may be permitted to run at large between the hours of 8:00 p.m. and 11:00 p.m. daily.

2B A fine of \$5.00 for each and every infraction of this section will be collected by the Provincial Police officer, and failure to pay such fine renders such owner liable to have his or her dog destroyed as provided for by this By-Law".

Effective immediately, this By-Law is going to be rigidly enforced.
