LIBRARY NEWSMy Brother's Keeper - Marcia Davenport

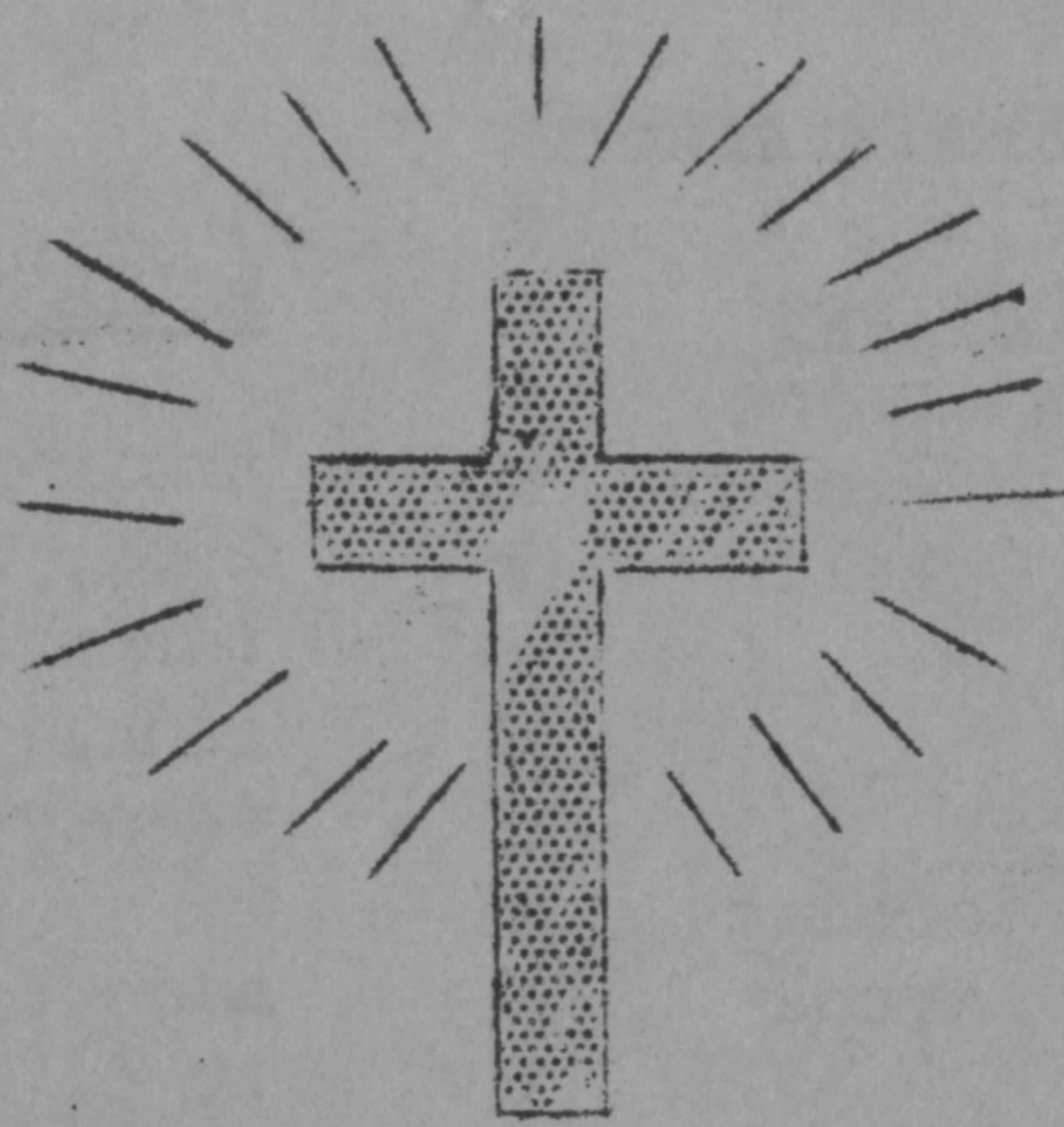
