CREDIT UNION NEWS

The Purpose of Govt. Inspection of Credit Unions

The purpose of government inspection is:

. 1. To verify the correctness of the annual statements filed with the Inspection Dept. to determine that proper accounting records and controls are maintained. This involves ascertaining that the financial statements not only agree with the records but they also reflect the true financial position with assets shown at realizable values and liabilities fully stated. 2. To reveal policy or trends likely to lead to financial difficulties and to take action to remedy such situations. This involves an appraisal of the capabilities of the officers and their interest in and application to their credit union duties. 3. To ensure that a credit union is being operated in accordance with the Act and its own by-laws.
