RECIPE OF THE WEEK

CHOCOLATE UPSIDE-DOWN CAKE

Sift, then measure:

1 cup all-purpose flour

Sift again with:

2 teaspoons baking powder

1/2 teaspoon salt

3/4 cup sugar

Work with a spoon until soft:

2 tablespoons shortening

Add sifted flour mixture with:

1/2 cup milk

1 teaspoon vanilla

1 cup chopped nut meats

Mix well. Pour into greased, shallow, round baking dish. Combine:

1/2 cup sugar

1/2 cup light-brown sugar

1/4 cup cocoa

Sprinkle on batter. Pour over batter:

1 cup boiling water

Bake in moderate oven (350°F.) for 45 minutes.

Cool. Cut into wedges. Top with whipped cream.
