RECIPE OF THE WEEK
SOUTHERN HASH

- 2 large onions
 - 1 lb. ground veal shoulder or rump
 - 1 No. 2 can (or 2½ cups cooked) tomatoes
 - 3 tbs. fat or salad oil
 - 1/2 cup uncooked rice
 - 1 tsp. chili powder
 - 1 tsp. salt
 - Few grains pepper
- Slice onions; brown in fat or salad oil. Add veal; brown. Add tomatoes, rice, chili powder, salt and pepper. Cover; cook slowly 30 minutes or until rice is tender, stirring occasionally.
