ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE: To be eligible to vote, a person must:

1. Be 21 years of age or over on June 9th.
2. Be a British subject
3. Have resided in Ontario for the twelve months preceding the day of polling (June 9th, 1955)
4. Be resident in the electoral district on May 2nd, 1955.

The Election Act provides that every employee eligible to vote shall have 3 consecutive hours while the polls are open for the purpose of casting his or her vote.

Day workers of the LongLac Pulp and Paper Company who are eligible to vote can find out from their supervisors how this provision of the Election Act affect them.
