as \$10 credit note have been donated.

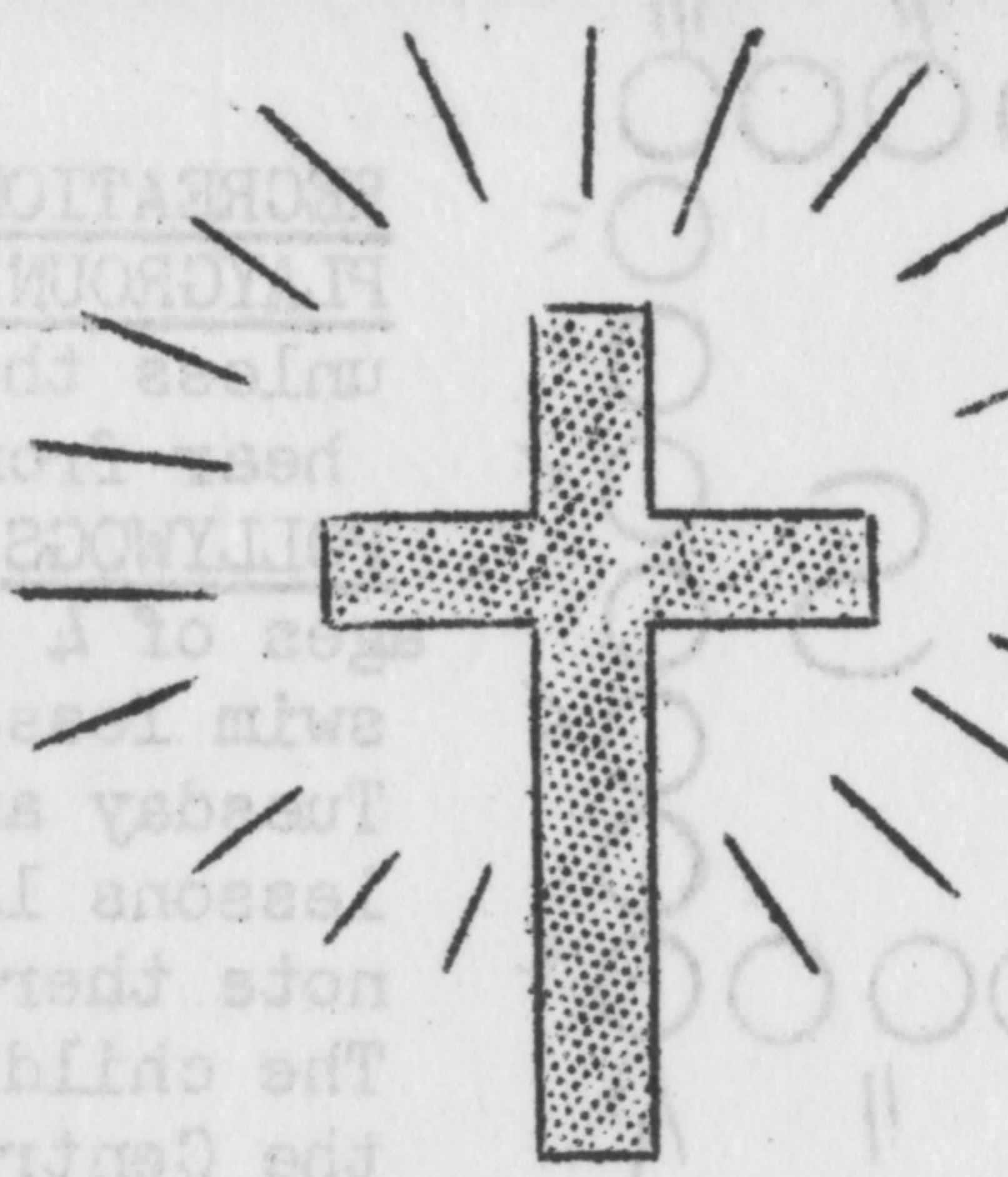
Don't miss last week's special
