## DATA NEEDED

- 1. Where the fish was caught
- 2. Date of recapture
- 3. Fork length (head to beginning of tail)
- 4. Girth (measured in front of dorsal fin)
- 5. Weight
- 6. Presence of lamprey marks
- 7. Take sample of scales near dorsal fin.
