

cup dark corn sirup
tbs. vinegar
tsp. salt
cup molasses
tbs. butter or margarine

cups puffed cereal

Mix corn sirup, vinegar, salt and molasses; cook slowly, stirring occasionally, to 240°F. (or when small quantity dropped into cold water forms semi-firm ball). Add butter or margarine. Quickly stir in cereal. Pack firmly into greased pan 8" x 8" x 2"; cool. Cut in 2" squares.
