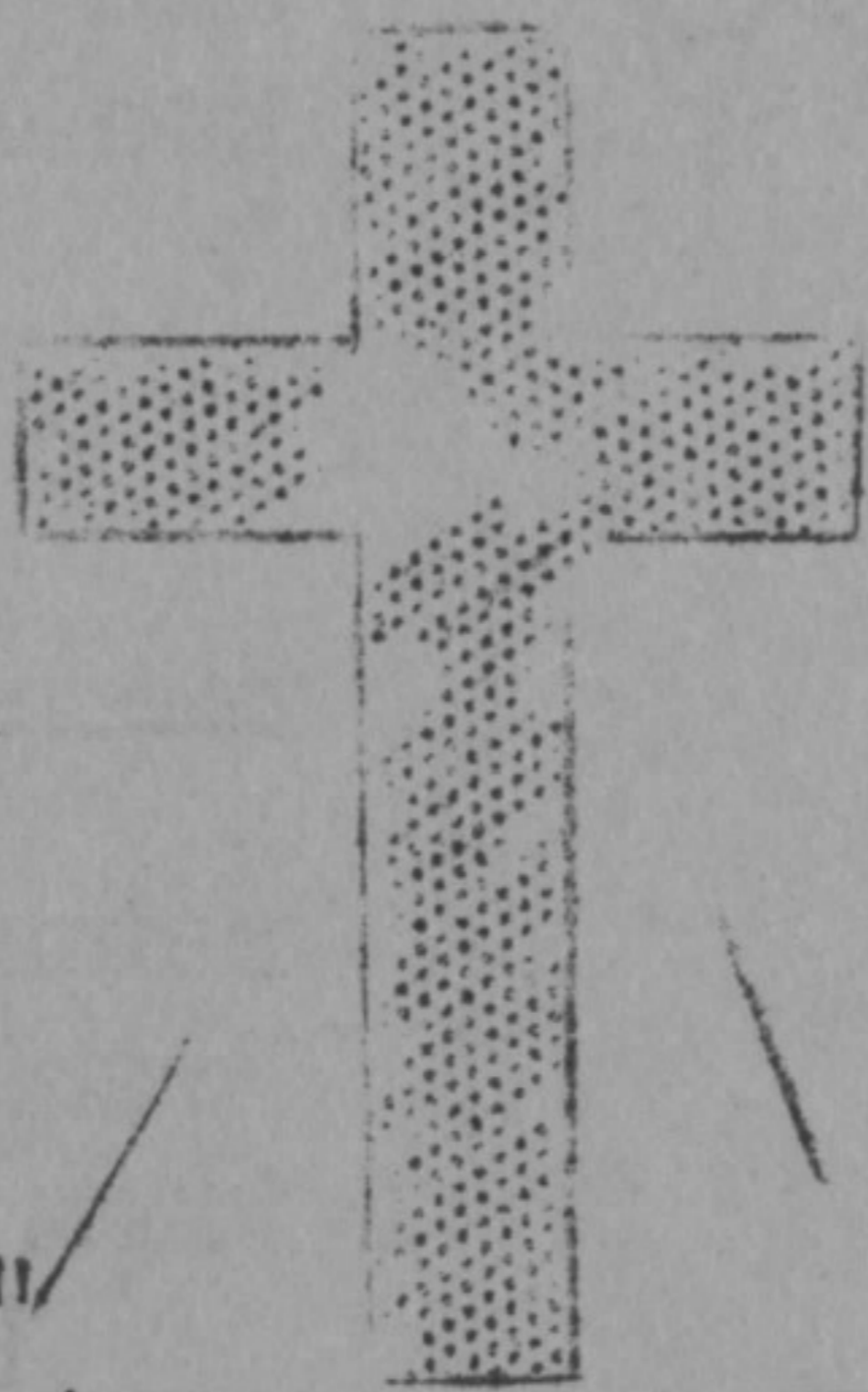

 7:30 p.m. Evening Service "Failures who made good"



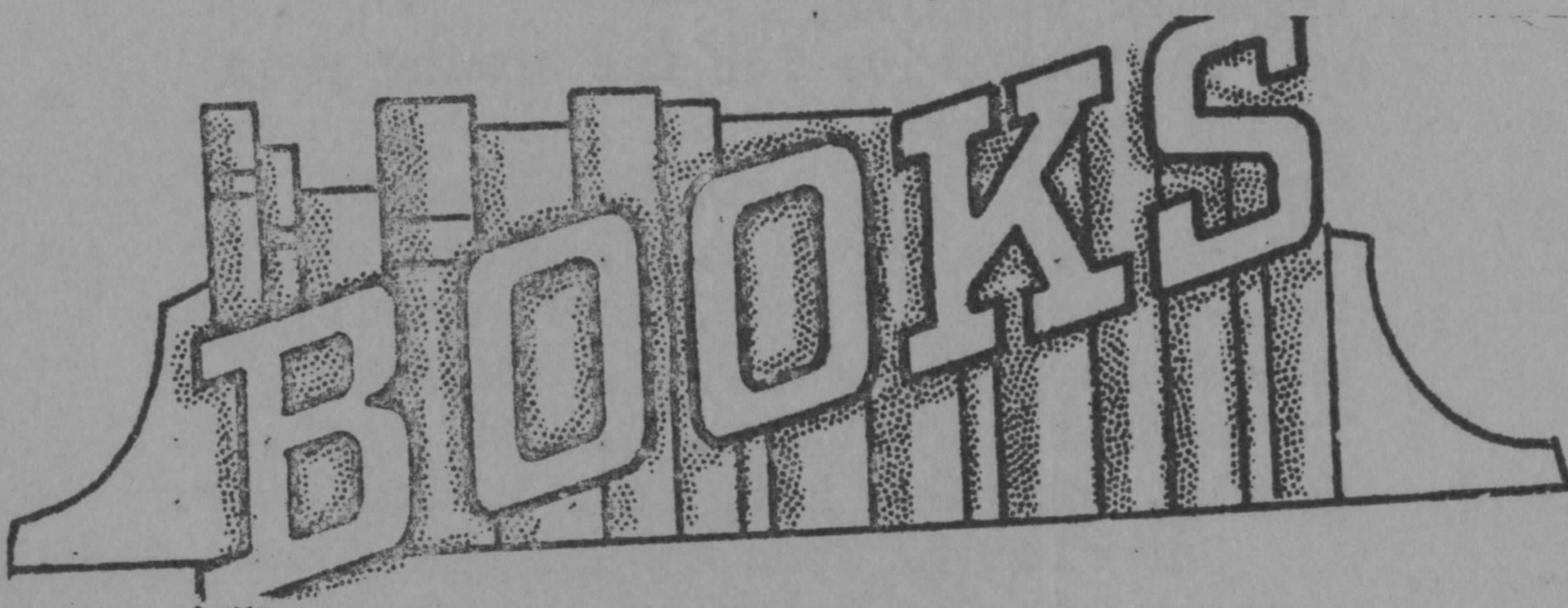
On Sunday, November 13th the Sacrament of Infant Baptism will be administered at the morning service. Parents who may wish to have a child baptized at this service will please contact the minister.
