

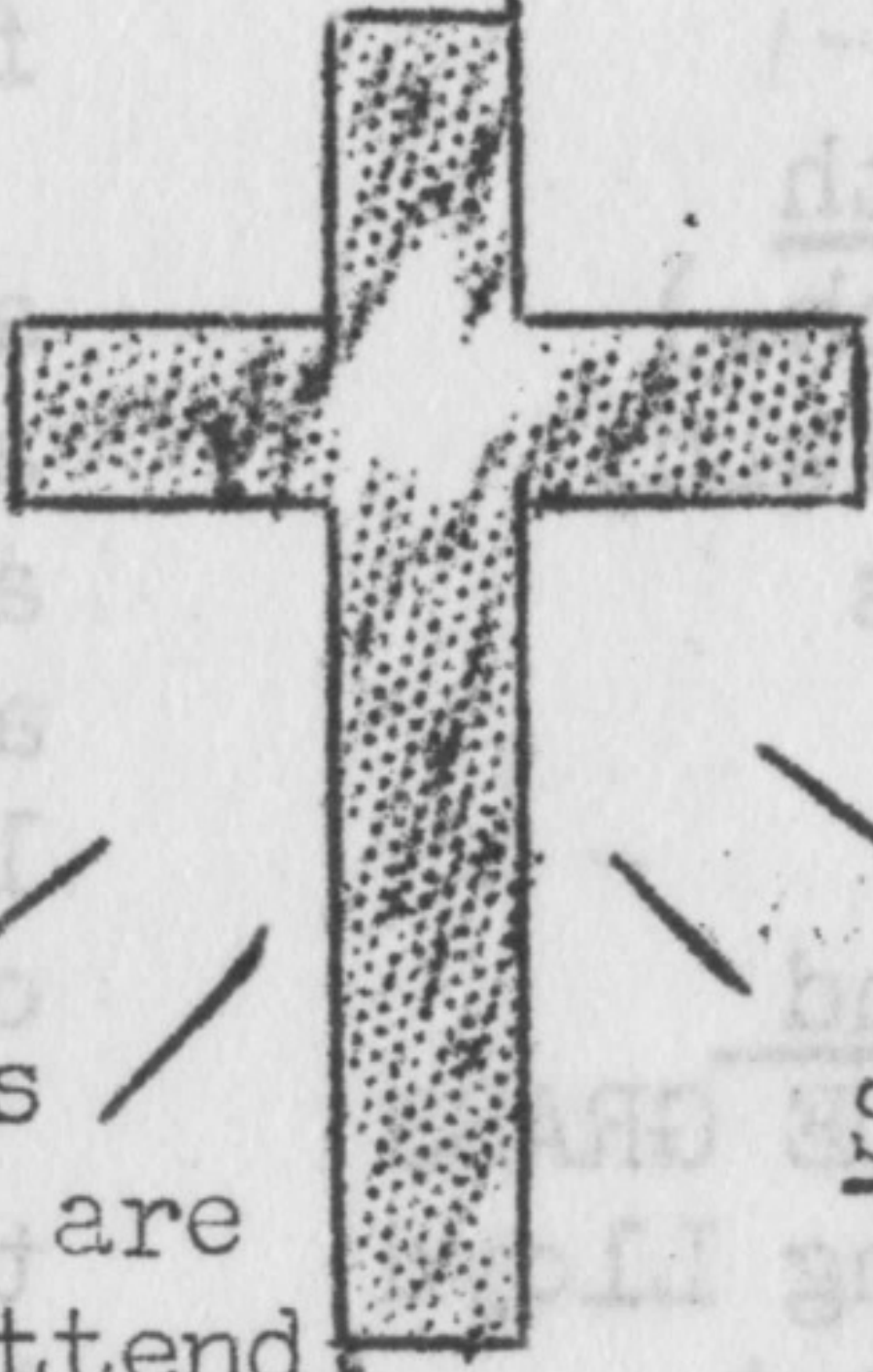

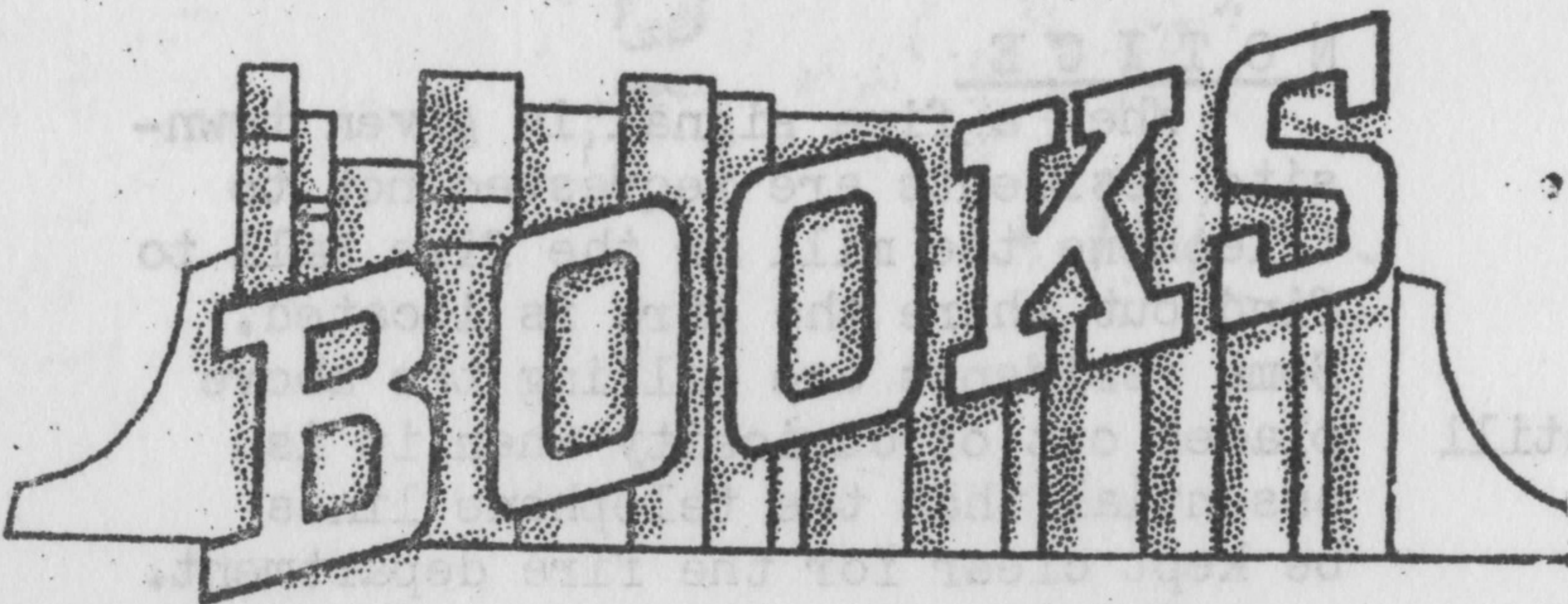
NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING
