Items which were discussed and action taken were as follows:

Bowling Alleys - All requests of the Bowling Association have been attended to except for the repair of the foul line lights. These are being worked on by the mill electrical dept.

Arena P.A. and Bunting - New ideas are being tried with the arena P.A. system and progress is being made. Bunting is to be installed along the arena trusses in order to beautify and also to control the sound.

Sale of Hockey Tickets - Present method of pre-sale and game sale is satisfactory and will be continued.

Arena Advertising Signs - J. Adamo, C. Paget and J. Fraser will submit a recommendation at a later date.

Rental of Curling Lounge During Curling Season - The individual must obtain permission from the curling club to rent the lounge during the curling season and the recreation director will tend to the rental from there on... A suitable agreement form is to be made up so that there is no misunderstanding of rates etc.

Inter-Connecting Brine System - A system to use either brine pump to control the ice system. To be placed in the 1956 budget.

Telephone In P.A. Booth - It was decided to instal a phone in the P.A. booth so that people could phone in or out for emergency purposes.

Cut of Gate for Exhibition Games - The Amateur Hockey Association is to be informed that any flat rate guarantee for an exhibition game is their responsibility in case the gate receipts are less than the guarantee.

Christmas Party Plans - The Christmas Party plans were approved as presented.

People in Aisles During Hockey Games - The arena attendant will attempt to do a better police service during hockey games in order to keep aisles clear, people from walking on seats etc.

Budget Committee - A. Driffield and J. Fraser will prepare the preliminary 1956 budget.

Mrs. A. Sinkins Retiring - This was the last meeting at which Mrs. Sinkins will be present as she is retiring from the committee at the termination of her term on January 1st. Mrs. Sinkins has been a loyal and faithful member of the committee and has never missed
